UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH

The Texas A&M Psychological and Brain Sciences programs generate scientific discoveries that shed light on psychological processes involved in human behavior. This includes identifying normal and disordered processes that contribute to mental and physical health disorders across the lifespan as well as the psychological and social processes that influence people's thoughts, feelings and behaviors as they engage with family, work and their community. Many of our majors contribute to these discoveries by participating in faculty laboratories for course credit (PBSI 491). Majors can also gain experience applying these principles in the field through PBSI 484 (internship) or in the classroom through PBSI 483 (teaching scholars).
