^{*}Prior approval for COMM 483 practicum and enrollment in COMM 483 during the experience is required.

Examples of projects suitable for COMM 483 include:

- Work/volunteer in a provider-patient position for 4-5 hours per week over a ten-week period.
- Work/volunteer in a non-classroom setting to assist with producing a health campaign for 4-5 hours per week over a ten-week period.
- Work/volunteer in a fundraising or public relations context in a healthcare-related context for 4-5 hours per week over a ten-week period.
- Work/volunteer with a health communication researcher 4-5 hours per week on health communication research over a ten-week period.

NOTE: 10-week duration is a required factor. It is not acceptable, for example, to volunteer 40 hours for one week or 20 hours for two weeks and so forth.
