HISP 691: Research

Guidelines and Criteria

In the Department of Hispanic Studies, 691 courses are special courses to meet the needs of students who are working on completing their dissertation. 691s are NOT for general use as electives.

Requirements/Conditions to register:

- 1. Completion of all coursework on the degree plan
- 2. Permission of the supervising faculty member
- 3. Approval of the Director of Graduate Studies

It is further understood that:

- 1. Individual consultation and agreement between student and faculty will precede this formal, written request.
- 2. There will be regular meetings between the student and the faculty supervisor as agreed upon at the beginning of the semester.
- 3. Although clock hours are not absolute, limiting or monitored, a general guideline is the expenditure of a minimum of 45 clock hours per semester hour of credit requested. This includes actual student-faculty contact hours as well as the time a student spends writing.
- 4. Specific writing goals should be agreed upon and fulfilled to obtain a passing grade.

Please return the completed, signed form to Cindy Hurt at least two weeks prior to the first day of the pre-registration period, corresponding to the semester you are requesting the course.
