### Notes

- For Engineering majors, ENGR/PHYS 216 and ENGR/PHYS 217 can count instead of PHYS 226 and PHYS 227.
- PHYS 218 and PHYS 208 may be used in place of PHYS 206/226 and 207/227.
- PHYS 309 is only offered in Spring semesters.
- PHYS 222 can not be used in the Physics minor, per Student Rule 14.16.
- If using PHYS 331 for the PHYS 3xx or 4xx requirement, contact Physics Advising to receive a major override for course registration.
- ASTR 314 may substitute for the PHYS 3xx or 4xx requirement. ASTR 314 is the only non-PHYS course that can be used towards the minor.
- PHYS 491 and PHYS 485 can not be used to meet the PHYS 3xx or 4xx requirement.
- Most 300-400 level PHYS courses have prerequisites not required in the minor. Instructor approval is required for any prerequisite overrides.
- A minimum of 6 hours of 300-400 level coursework must be taken at TAMU to complete a minor (Student Rule 14.16)
